


THREE KINDS OF STUDENTS: VICTIMS, AGGRESSORS AND CREATORS

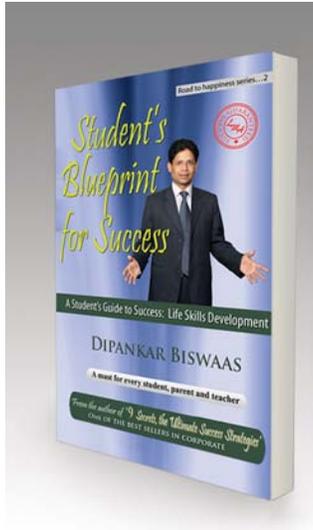
